## A Message from the SPP Executive

People in Saskatchewan have always had exceptional capacity for generosity, kindness, and providing service in their communities.

This genuine warmth, co-operative ingenuity, and communal spirit distinguishes our people from other places throughout North America.

These virtues helped us weather social and cultural storms for generations, and they will help us reconcile with injustices, past and present.

#### But our Province has a problem.

The Saskatchewan Public *have endured* the past 17 years of cruel, callous, and nakedly selfish governance of the infamous SaskParty.

They've given away public assets to private owners, destroying local communities' economies each time.

They've severed connections between families and communities by killing the Saskatchewan Transportation Company – deliberately making Rural residents into second-class citizens overnight.

Their Party has used and pitted our dedicated Ministries' civil servants against each other while orchestrating corrupt land deals, engaging in anti-social criminal activity, and cutting deals for well-off corporations.

They suppressed life-saving information during a global pandemic, and had the worst outcomes of any province. They've punished whistleblowers and critics for over 17 years.

And they've used the Notwithstanding Clause to oppress school children, and to send a hateful message to the 2SLGBTQ+ community.

They've done all these things because it benefits them. Their contempt for the Public extends to their own colleagues: they've surveilled each other, and they've even brought weapons into their workplace.

This is the nature of their Anti-Social politics. Every interaction must be a cold transaction. Critics must be monitored. Every donation matched with a contract.

They think that people should suffer in silence, and even die for the economy, and quietly.

This is the inevitable result of cutting services for 40 years, and lionizing it.

The wellbeing of people should not be considered an expense.

### Let's call a Spade a Spade.

Despite their myriad flaws, the SaskParty has controlled the province virtually unopposed in the Legislature.

Their most inspired legislative critics have served single terms, or fraught double terms, amongst a dysfunctional, petrified Official Opposition. The NDP have slowly, but obediently followed the SaskParty's lead: the NDP are outright endorsing Conservative policies today, like ending the Carbon Rebate, enacting anti-democratic changes to the Election Act, and denying Treaty Rights through the Sask. First Act.

Half of all voters were not inspired to vote in 2020. Faith and hope in the Saskatchewan government continues to decline because both establishment parties are cynical, calculating, and untrustworthy. They serve themselves, and their conduct ripples through the province, damaging relationships at work and at home.

We need a Government that helps all people. We must stop settling for legislators who serve themselves.



#### The stakes are too high to sit out.

The Saskatchewan Public has done their best work through progressive grassroots organizing over the past 17 years. Progressive groups have fought and defeated the SaskParty on several occasions.

They've been successful not because of the NDP, but in spite of the NDP. These Progressive movements have been more successful without the NDP in the 21<sup>st</sup> century, and many times before.

People who care about helping everyone will always have a place in the Saskatchewan Progress Party.

We need to fight anti-social policies and movements on all fronts. The Progressive movement, serving and supported by the Public, must have democratic representation again in the Saskatchewan Legislature. We must build power together so we can defeat all three austerity parties currently in office.

The Saskatchewan Progress Party, with the Policies described throughout this Platform, aims to serve as the legislative wing for all socially-conscious, inclusive, just, and generous people who want to build fundamental social change – for the good of all.

Our world is facing multiple inter-related crises. Violence, genocide, greedinduced poverty, and an insecure climate must be combatted from all sides.

We cannot use the same logic that caused our problems in the first place. Unregulated crony capitalism must be replaced to save our communities.

Community Morale is extremely important to us – we won't give up on our promises. Past compromises and half-measures have led to this dysfunctional status quo. We'll start by holding the balance of power in a minority government – and we know that's more meaningful than a couple Cabinet positions.

A Healthy Future is long overdue. We've been close before, and we can do even better today.

## Our Plan will:

- End Burnout and Rebuild Universal Healthcare.
  - Public Healthcare must be staffed up and expanded profit motives must be eliminated where life and death are concerned, in cities and towns.
  - Patient quality of service will improve, and Staff will be protected from violence.
  - ✓ The Healthcare system will recover through Modern Social Service Funding, Safe Consumption Sites, and a Housing First Model.
- **Rebuild Social Democratic Values** in the Legislature and civil service.
  - Public service should never be run on the same logic as business the Profit Motive must be replaced with a Morale Motive.
  - We'll repeal terrible Bills passed by the SaskParty such as the Parents' Bill of Rights, the Saskatchewan Marshalls, and the Sask First Act.
  - Labour Rights must be expanded for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century workplace We'll make it happen with direct input from workers.
  - All publicly funded savings funds will need to divest from military investments.



- Reform our Electoral System.
  - ✓ We are committed to moving on from our cynical, unrepresentative voting system toward Ranked Choice Voting, so people aren't afraid to vote first for the Party they like most.
  - ✓ You'll never need to settle for useless big tent parties again.
  - ✓ We'll create space for Indigenous people in the Legislature with Indigenous MLAs.
  - And we'll remove patently obvious sources of corruption through Donation Restrictions and Bans on MLAs holding Private Investments.
- Expand Staffing Throughout our Public Education systems.
  - We need more Teachers, more Educational Assistants, Mental Health staff in all schools, and they need safer workplaces to serve students.
  - ✓ Private Schools must have substantial reforms and weekly oversight.
- End Poverty, Homelessness, and Fight Crime through healing models.
  - Healing models are proven to cost less than the anti-social status quo

     and they'll build social morale again.
  - We can easily lead the country on Housing First programs, Rent Controls, Non-Medical Emergency Staff to protect domestic violence survivors, and provide a 20% funding increase to Assisted Income and Disability Benefit recipients to foster dignified lives in our communities.
  - Livable Minimum Wages and Guaranteed Livable Basic Income are needed, and Minimum Wage exemptions must end to protect vulnerable people.
- Build Public Housing through Existing Crowns.
  - ✓ The private sector has repeatedly reneged on promises to provide affordable housing since 2007 – we'll make it happen by expanding the Sask. Housing Corp.
- Protect Jobs and the Environment.
  - We'll lead the country and drive Young Canadians to Saskatchewan for Free Green Energy Training.
  - ✓ We'll staff up with Sustainable Careers in the revitalized Ministry of Environment, SaskPower, and the Saskatchewan Climate Corps.



We can afford a Better Province by Removing Anti-Social Barriers throughout the Government, Raising Revenues from the Private Sector, and Building Public Sector Revenue Sources.
